

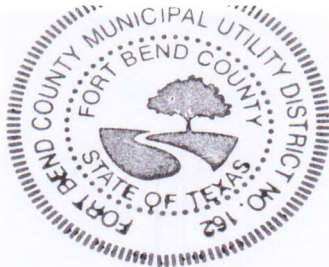
NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 162

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 162 will hold a special meeting on **Thursday, July 17, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Si Environmental, LLC, 6420 Reading Road, Rosenberg, TX 77471, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Security matters, including renewal of Interlocal Agreement for Additional Law Enforcement Services with Fort Bend County.
3. Garbage collection services.
4. Report on maintenance, ownership, and construction of drainage, detention, recreational, and landscaping facilities, and authorize appropriate action.
5. Phase II MS4 Stormwater Plan implementation and stormwater permitting matters, including review public comment.

 - i. update from District engineer on Texas Commission on Environmental Quality inspection of facilities.
