FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 162

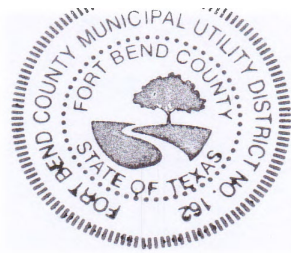
The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 162 will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, October 1, 2026, at 5:00 p.m., at the offices of Si Environmental, LLC, 6420 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:
